When Tammy Wynette died in April 1998, a month shy of her 56th birthday, country music lost not only its "First Lady" but its Once and Future Queen of Brave-Faced Heartache. Born Virginia Wynette Pugh in Mississippi's cotton country, she'd known more than her share of hard nuts. These, along with the troubles she'd seen in her ill-starred marriages, informed her double-tracked vocals to their very core. Though Wynette's plaintive domestic dramas spoke with a special acuity to her countless female fans, the heart in her voice was universal.

Stand By Your Man, from 1968, was the first of her twenty Number One Country hits. The single sold six million copies while also establishing co-writer Billy Sherrill as Nashville's foremost record producer of the 1970s. On this remastered and expanded edition of the album—featuring two bonus tracks—Tammy Wynette truly sings her heart out.
